The Mexique table desk designed by Charlotte Perriand was developed as a desk for the dorm rooms at the Maison du Mexique at Paris' Cité Internationale Universitaire, the Mexique series was originally fabricated by Les Ateliers Jean Prouvé which led to confusing misattribution of the design over the past several decades.

The Mexique table's thick, exquisitely sculpted triangular top with rounded edge profiles was part of Perriand's solution of creating a surface with an atypical foot print that could easily be maneuvered within a very small living space.
