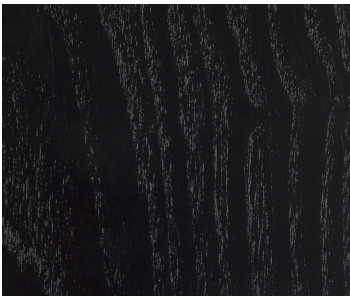


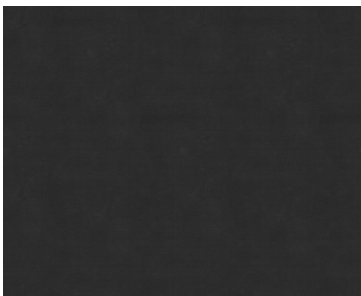
Doron Hotel Chair

Designed by Charlotte Perriand

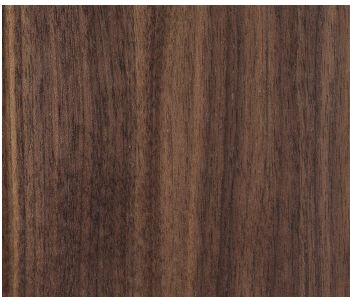
The Doron Hotel chair was designed in 1947 by Charlotte Perriand, a real mountain lover, for the winter sports resort of Méribel Les Allues and for Hôtel Doron, one of the first chalet hotels, in the same location. The French designer always had a special and profound relationship with nature; in fact, she was one of the first to explore the relationship between man and his surrounding environment, seeking natural materials to use in her projects.



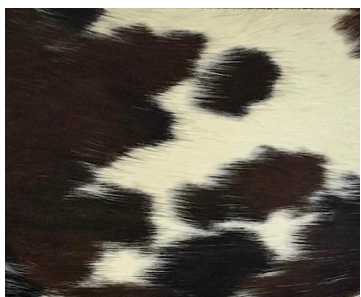
Black Stained Ash

American Walnut



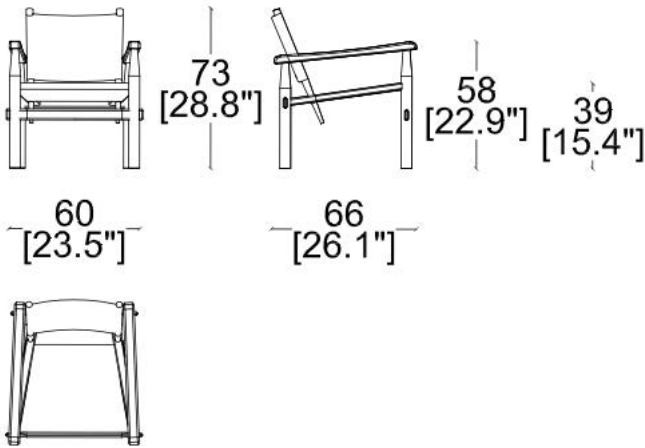
Black Brown and White Hairy Hide
