

Lina Lounge Chair

Designed by Gianfranco Frattini, c. 1955/2018



Lina lounge chair, designed by Gianfranco Frattini for Tacchini, features an unusual wood frame that lends it a solid yet lightweight appearance. Its singularity lay in the slender legs and bent plywood element that supports the side of the seat back and curves up to become the 'wing' upon which the armrests sit. Lina is a re-edition of one of the earliest projects designed by Gianfranco Frattini, one of the great masters of Italian design. Nominated in 1955 for the Compasso d'oro, the lounge chair represents a very innovative artistry technique for its time, carried out today with historical accuracy.

Base: open pore stained solid ash wood.
