As a minimalist, Ole Wanscher had a preference for slim and refined form; the Colonial Chair, Wanscher's most famous design to this day, garners its strength from carefully designed bracing. The chair's slightly curved armrests rise to a point before turning downward, a trademark Wanscher feature. The legs are made of roundwood timber, with the back legs curving gently outward for increased stability and a more refined aesthetic.
