While Philipp Mainzer developed the Sloane table to embody many of the classic elements that figure prominently within his other iconic dining table designs for e15, he also characterized it with a “slimmer” feel that would connote levity elegance. While available in e15’s standard range of table sizes, the Sloane table is also available in some notably smaller widths that are better suited to smaller living spaces. Sloane table features a 1.6” solid wood top that is perceived as flush with the tops of each of its corner placed square legs. Like Mainzer’s other e15 table designs, the top of each leg becomes part of the top’s horizontal expanse. Sloane table’s simplicity lends itself to use with many dining chair styles, providing the user additional opportunities to personalize the desired overall dining aesthetic.

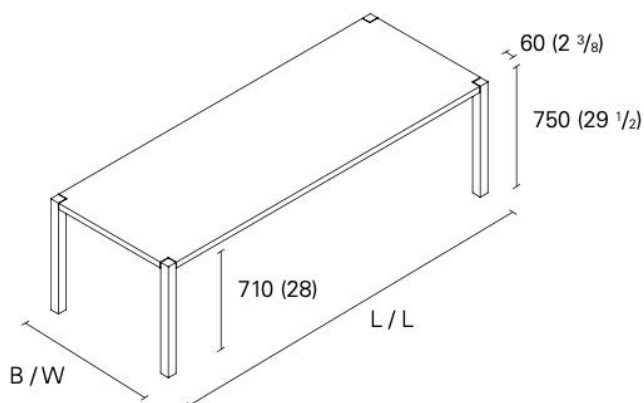
