DE S CRIPTION

More than 50 years have passed since Soriana's initial design by Afra and Tobia Scarpa, and the lounge chair continues to amaze with a new limited-edition denim series for Cassina. Through the use of denim, the quintessential casual fabric, the series elevates the unconventional spirit of the design, which sought to bring casual comfort home in the 1960s. Premium Japanese denim is chosen to clad the distinctive Soriana curves, as it is a culturally prized material well-known and soughtafter for its superior quality. The denim is woven on antique looms to produce a "self-edge" or exposed, narrow natural border, which runs along the outer seam and lateral profiles. After completing the upholstery, it moves to a specialized laundering facility, where it undergoes a process of scratching and sanding to produce the distinctive look of worn, faded jeans. Then to soften the denim, it undergoes several washes with pumice stones.

STRUCTURE

Base: recyclable CARB* certified wood panel, with low-level formaldehyde emissions Padding: in BioFoam microspheres (inner) and 100% recycled blown PET from Plastic Bank (outer)

Clamp: in powder-coated steel, in blue, black, or white

Upholstery: premium Japanese denim in indigo, ecru, and black


